The Event

OWASP BeNeLux 2025 will take place on **Tuesday, 2 December, and Wednesday, 3 December, 2025**, at **Lamot, Mechelen, Belgium**. This two-day event brings together security professionals from Belgium, the Netherlands, and beyond to share knowledge, learn from industry experts, and discuss emerging trends in application security.

The event features:

- The Conference on 2nd of December featuring international and local speakers covering key OWASP topics and broader challenges of Security.
- Hands-On training sessions on 3rd of December delivered by experienced practitioners on security topics.

Our chapters regularly organize meetings with expert talks and panel discussions, typically gathering around **80 attendees** and reaching over **1,500 security practitioners** across Belgium and the Netherlands.

OWASP BeNeLux has a strong tradition of fostering community and knowledge-sharing. Previous editions, held at venues such as the University of Leuven, CORDA Campus in Hasselt, RAI Amsterdam, Jaarbeurs Utrecht, and the University of Luxembourg, have brought together over an average of 280 attendees from across the region. In 2025, we aim to welcome more than 250 participants, continuing to build connections and share insights with the security community.

Sponsors

1. What will be the dimensions of the booth?
Depending on your Sponsorship package you will be provided with tables of approximate dimensions of either 1mx1m or 2mx2m with two chairs and a power outlet in the area designated to you.
2. What will be the dimensions of the Banner roll up?
The sponsor has to provide their own banner where a Gold Sponsor can place regular 1x2 banners and platinum sponsors can place larger banners.
3. Will there be electricity provided or do we have to pay for it?
Electricity will be provided.
4. Do we have Wifi available at the event and do we have to pay for it?
Wifi will be provided for free at the venue.
5. Do we get screens and equipment?
OWASP doesn't provide any screens or equipment's. It is the sole responsibility of the sponsor to arrange and vacate it at the end of the event. Please reach out to one of the volunteers in time to see if we can help you.
